Soliciting Auction items is easier than many people believe. When you make a purchase, have a meal at a restaurant, take your car in for an oil change, buy flowers, etc. please take a couple minutes and ask the owner or manager for an Auction Donation for Tabor 100 to help fund scholarships for deserving students. You may have something of great value at your home you have forgot about, check the basement and your closets.

Best Sellers: (Items that sell out over 85% of the time)

- Restaurant Certificates – Easy to get, just ask the restaurant’s manager while you are dining there. Most people will make a drive to the restaurant (e.g. Island Soul) to support Tabor and the Donor.
- Sports equipment (kids equipment is very popular)
- Professional Sports Tickets – donate a game from your season ticket package
- A popular athlete or sports team cards
- Signed, framed photos of famous sports personalities – check your closet.
- One week use of yours or a friend’s vacation home or timeshare.
- High quality/stylish luggage
- Gift Baskets – Value often greater than the sum of the parts. Have fun building an attractive basket of goodies.
- Handmade Items – Value is usually overstated (no Granny dresses, etc.)
- Wine – Always a winner
- Airline trips Donate your air miles. Airline tickets or miles do not have to originate from major sponsors, like Alaska Airlines.
- Cigars, men love cigars
- Electronic Items – TV, DVD players, MP3, Electronic games.
- Art – Art displayed on the Live or Silent tables is a great attention grabber.
- Jewelry – also a great attention grabber. Volunteers create a safe display method before the day of the event. All donated jewelry will need to be received ASAP for the safe display preparation.
- Wine tasting – check with management when you take a wine tour or attend a commercial tasting event.
- Gas cards - If you do not have time to solicit, this would be an effective donation for Tabor’s benefit.
- You or a friend donate a day cruise on a cruiser, often along with cocktails. Fun for everyone!
In the past these have always sold at a high bid price.
- Pet sitting or boarding – If someone takes care of your pet, ask the owner to donate a certificate.
- Several hours of landscaping – ask your gardener to donate a certificate.
- Local florist delivery certificate
- Several hours of certified mechanic work, ask the manager or owner when you take your car in for servicing.
- Oil changes at a shop or quick oil change franchise, ask the manager or owner when you take your car in for servicing.
- Car wash certificates (e.g. Elephant Car Wash) – every car owner can use this, ask the manager or owner.
- Pro lessons for any sport
- Tee times at golf course
- Tailgate party - either purchase from a caterer or you be the host and include at least two game tickets. Fun for everyone!
- Cooking lesson from a pro.
- Subs or burgers for 20 people delivered to work or home
